



Community Events in Parks Fee Structure

1. Basic Park Fee

This fee contributes to the cost of the administration of the community event program and care for the park system.

- A. Non-profit organization, public agency, partner; no fee charged to event participants
\$300 for the first day
\$150 for each additional day

- B. Non-profit organization, public agency, partner; admission/entry fee is charged to participants
\$350
\$150 for each additional day

- C. Commercial, for-profit organization, private group or individual; no admission/entry fee is charged to participants
\$500
\$150 for each additional day

- D. Commercial, for-profit organization, private group or individual; admission/entry fee is charged to participants
\$1000
\$150 for each additional day

2. Impact Fee

Events have varying degrees of impact to a park. This component of the park total use fees is based upon: Quantity of park visitors, impact on turf, event footprint, quantity of vendors/booths, blow up toys, prior event experience, etc.

High Impact Event	-----	\$500
Moderate Impact	-----	\$250
Low Impact	-----	\$100

3. Optional BPRD Services:

BPRD on-site event staff support:	\$ 30 per hour
Garbage can rental	\$ 3 each
Barricade Rental	\$ 3 each, capped at \$25
No Parking Sign Rental	\$ 3 each, capped at \$25

Vehicle Access Permit

Cars	\$ 25 each
Pick up/trucks	\$ 35 each
Truck-trailers	\$ 50 each
Large delivery trucks	\$100 each

Pass through and Running Events:

- Pass through running events: There is no charge to running events passing through a park, without staging or other district service requirements. However, pass through events require district permission, completion of an event description form and proof of insurance coverage.
- Events staged on non-district property but needing district services will be charged \$30 per hour for administrative and/or other services.
