Pine Nursery Park Sports Fields Open for Play

This Saturday the sports fields at Pine Nursery Park, at 3750 NE Purcell Blvd., will be used for the first time. Bend Park & Recreation Girls Softball will play at 9:30 a.m. on May 1.

Acquiring this 159-acre park site took four years and two acts of congress. It was the former home of the US Forest Service's pine seedling nursery. After acquiring the land it took five more years to plan and build phase one of Pine Nursery Park. Phase one includes: Four softball fields with a 60-70 ft. baseline and a 325 ft. outfield fence, four soccer fields that can be overlaid for seasonal/tournament play, an irrigation pond that is stocked for fishing programs, a fenced dog off-leash area, a 1.3 mile loop trail and access to large natural areas.
