1.2 NOTICE TO PROPOSER

- A. This Addendum is issued through Bend Park and Recreation District pursuant to the Instructions to Proposer and Conditions of the Contract. This Addendum serves to clarify, revise, and supersede information in the Project Manual, Drawings, and previously issued Addenda. Portions of the Addendum affecting the Contract Documents will be incorporated into the Contract by enumeration of the Addendum in the Owner/Contractor Agreement.
- B. The date for receipt of proposals is unchanged by this Addendum, at same time and location.

C. Questions Asked and Answers

- 1. Question: Mats for JSFC a Vendor asked if smaller mats we're allowed, in reference to the 6x10, 3x19, 3x16, and 4x20. Will 3x10's and combinations thereof be allowed or not be allowed? There is an extremely large difference in costs.

The Mat types and Sizes are very clear on The RFP, Smaller, or Combination of Smaller mats in a single area to duplicate the current mat configuration will not be accepted, as this would leave an unsafe trip hazard at the overlaying mat seams.

2. Question: The District requested Sure Step mats in some locations, and Vendor asked if cleated back was acceptable. Will the District allow this substitution for this Proposal Request?

The District will accept equal to or better than the product identified, but the mat must not slip on the polished hard surface floors at all locations and must be the specified dimensions.

3. Question: Splash Steady mat 3x4 at the Pavilion is a Water Hog Brand mat. Is this what is required?

The quality of the mat specified in the RFP or equal to or better than, is what the District will require and be the sole judge of whether any other brand will be acceptable.

4. Question: For the District Office what does "Daily" mean?

"Daily" for the District Office and Senior Center means Monday through Friday 8 am to 5 pm and service will need to be provided during these hours.

5. Question: Is the District requesting all Red Microfiber cloths in every location?

The District requires all cloths to be Red.

6. Question: Was the inventory for Senior Center doubled on floor mats?

The RFP indicates the number that is required for this facility.

7. Question: Is the Microfiber cloth pad at Park Services a Velcro style mop? Tools not included?

This is incorrect. The RFP states, under Park Services, "Micro Fiber Pad", which is an 18" with Velcro backing. The District will provide all hardware, the RFP is for cloth only.
