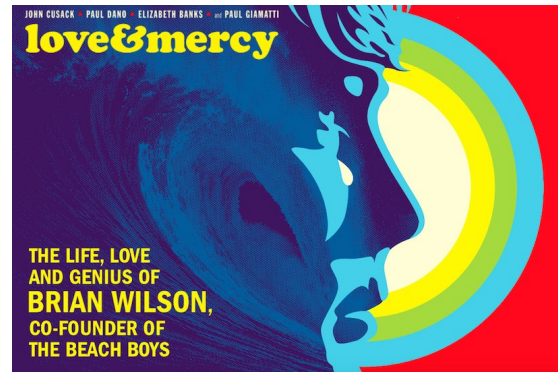

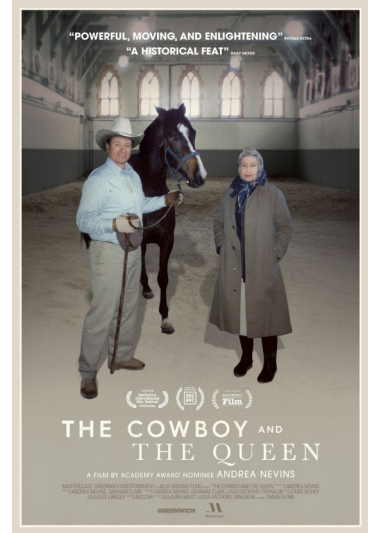
## July 9
