Sealed proposals will be accepted by David Crowther at the Bend Park and Recreation District Administration Office, 799 SW Columbia Street, Bend, Oregon 97702 until 2:00 pm local time, July 26, 2018, at which time and place proposing will be closed, and the proposals opened but not read. No proposals will be received after closing.

The work includes, but is not limited to: A strategic plan which is concise and easy-to-understand, relies heavily upon graphics, photos, tables and charts to convey information, rather than using lengthy text, includes a template for a succinct, easy-to-track Annual Action Plan, includes tangible performance and includes a method for tracking progress.
