





High vs. Moderate Need





Scholarship \$ Used Per Household



- Over 100 free opportunities last year
- Community Events

Program Changes in 2019-20

- Increased income eligibility level for high need from 100% to 130% of poverty
- Increase complementary program support from 25% to 50% for moderate need
- Removed limitation on facility passes
- Streamlined income verification; aligned with other assistance programs
- Extended eligibility period to one-year

Outreach & Communication

- Enhance awareness and access to District assistance programs
- Rebrand "Needs-Based Assistance" to "Recreation Scholarship Program"
- Creation and distribution of a brochure
- Improve visibility in Playbook, website, social media
- Increased outreach to targeted populations
- Continued use of community partners

FY 20-21 NBA Plan


- Continue all changes made to Scholarship Program


