


The following results are a compilation of **all** feedback collected during the second round of public outreach via the online surveys, the in-person information event and the online comment form.




The majority of respondents prefer Design Concept #2.










The majority of respondents believe that the 8-stall parking lot is the most appropriate option for this park.










The large majority of respondents would like a Natural Area in the park.









The minority of respondents would like an Open Lawn Area in the park.








A majority of respondents would like a Shaded Lawn Area in the park.








The large majority of respondents would like a Multiuse Path in the park.








The majority of respondents believe the Picnic Shelter is the most appropriate option for this park.








The majority of respondents believe that either a Multiuse Court or an Art feature are the most appropriate options for this park.










The large majority of respondents would like a Half-Court Basketball for this park.










The majority of respondents believe that Landforms are the most appropriate option for this park.











The majority of respondents believe swing example #1 is most appropriate for this park.






The majority of respondents believe spinner example #1 is most appropriate for this park.








The majority of respondents believe that climber example #2 is most appropriate for this park.






The large majority of respondents believe that slide example #1 is most appropriate for this park.












The large majority of respondents believe that balancing example #4 is most appropriate for this park.











The majority of respondents believe that sensory example #4 is most appropriate for this park.





























## **Next Steps**
