

Thank you for considering Riverbend Park for your public event. The information below provides you with specific event details for the use of Riverbend Park.

Riverbend Park is located near the Old Mill District (OMD). All events in the park are scheduled in cooperation with the OMD and will require approval from OMD and Bend Park and Recreation District. Event organizers should be aware that concerts at Hayden Homes Amphitheatre (HHA) may be scheduled as late as 30 days prior to an event. Pre-scheduled events at Riverbend Park do not prevent a concert scheduling at the HHA.

Alcohol

If alcohol is sold the district requires the area to be hard fenced and located near the shelter away from the river access area.

Amenities

- 2.75 acres of turf area/pods available for public events.
- 12 feet and 8 feet wide hard surface pathways around two large lawn areas give vendors easy access for vendor setup and cleanup.
- Vendor tents set up along the turf adjacent to pathways allow for ADA accessibility.
- 50-amp electricity is available at five locations around the perimeter of the lawn areas.
- Potable water is available at the shelter.
- A 1,900 square foot shelter with four picnic tables.
- Park entrance gate unlocked at 5:00 am and locked at 10:00 pm.

Amplified Sound

Riverbend Park is suitable for **acoustic music only** – no electrically enhanced or modified sounds. Electric guitars, drums, large amplifiers and sound boards are prohibited.

Irrigation:

Due to the reoccurring water shortage each year, we cannot guarantee that irrigation will be operating through the end of the event season. If irrigation is shut off early due to low water levels, event setup may need to be reduced or altered to be on hard surfaces. Inflatables, food trucks, and any other items that will cause an impact to the turf will be prohibited.

Parking/Vehicles

- There are 120 parking spaces shared by trail, river, building and park users.
- All street parking on Columbia St. and Shevlin Hixon is on OMD property. Permission to extend parking beyond the park's capacity must be approved by the OMD.
- Vehicle access to the park grounds requires pre-approval from the district.

Any variance from the park use conditions must be pre-approved by Bend Park and Recreation District.
