

Thank you for considering Alpenglow Park for your public event. The information below provides you with specific event details for the use of Alpenglow Park.

### Amenities

- Four acres of turf area conducive to special events
- 12 feet wide asphalt pathways around the lawn areas give vendors easy access for vendor setup and cleanup.
- Vendor tents set up along the turf, on the inside of the asphalt pathway, adjacent to pathways allow for ADA accessibility.
- Covered, 39 ft by 17 ft event stage with 6 ft access aisles on either side.
- Electrical service at event stage:
  - Two, 50 Amp 240-Volt single wall mounted receptacles
  - One, 30 Amp 240-Volt single wall mounted receptacle
  - Four, 20 Amp 120-Volt double duplex wall mounted receptacles
  - Three, 20 Amp 120-Volt duplex wall mounted receptacles
  - Three, 20 Amp 120-Volt duplex ceiling mounted receptacles
- Potable water is available at the picnic shelter.
- Concrete portable restroom pad for up to approximately 10 units (includes one ADA unit)

### Parking/Vehicles

- 159 parking spaces are available on-site between the north, main, and south parking lots. These spaces are shared by trail and park users and are not exclusive to events.
- Event organizers are encouraged to coordinate with the Bend-La Pine School District to secure additional parking at nearby Caldera High School. Shuttling between sites may be necessary and should be included in the parking plan.

Any variance from the park use conditions must be pre-approved by Bend Park and Recreation District.
