

Thank you for considering Alpenglow Park for your event. The information below provides you with specific details for the use of Alpenglow Park.

### Amenities

- Four acres of turf area are conducive to special events.
- Covered, 39 feet by 17 feet event stage with 6-foot access aisles on either side.
- A picnic shelter with six tables.
- 12-foot-wide asphalt pathways around the lawn areas give vendors easy access for vendor setup and cleanup.
- Vendor tents set up along the turf adjacent to pathways allow for ADA accessibility.
- Electrical service at event stage:
  - Two, 50-Amp 240-Volt single wall mounted receptacles
  - One, 30-Amp 240-Volt single wall mounted receptacle
  - Four, 20-Amp 120-Volt double duplex wall mounted receptacles
  - Three, 20-Amp 120-Volt duplex wall mounted receptacles
  - Three, 20-Amp 120-Volt duplex ceiling mounted receptacles
- Electrical service at picnic shelter
  - Two, 20-Amp 120-Volt duplex wall mounted receptacles
- Potable water is available at the picnic shelter.
- Concrete portable restroom pad for up to approximately 10 units (includes one ADA unit)
- Park entrance gate unlocked at 5:00 am and locked at 10:00 pm.

### Amplified Noise

- Per district policy, amplified sound may begin no earlier than 10:00 am (vs. 7:00 am per City of Bend (COB) ordinance) and must end at 9:00 pm Sunday – Thursday and 10:00 pm Friday – Saturday. This includes sound check and setup.

### Parking/Vehicles

- 159 parking spaces are available on-site between the north, main, and south parking lots. These spaces are shared by trail and park users and are not exclusive to events.
- Contact [Bend La Pine School District](#) for possible use of the Caldera High School parking lot. If approved, shuttling between sites may be necessary and should be included in the parking plan.
- The Bridges is a private neighborhood located on the east side of 15<sup>th</sup> Street across from Alpenglow Park. Event organizers must communicate to event staff and attendees that parking is prohibited in that neighborhood. BPRD will provide a “No Event Parking” sign to place on the corner of Gateway Dr. and SE 15<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Vehicle access to park grounds require paid fees and pre-approval by the district.

Any variance from the park use conditions must be pre-approved by Bend Park and Recreation District.
