# Sylvan Park Playground Renovation Project

#### **Community Survey #2 Summary**

This second round of outreach, held in winter 2025, gathered feedback on specific playground concepts and equipment preferences. The summary results are provided below, with the full response dataset attached. Thank you for your time and valuable input—your feedback continues to shape the future of Sylvan Park.

#### Who participated?

- 79 responses received
- Largest age groups: 35–44 (35%), 6-12 (22%), 65+ (16%) and 2-5 (10%)

#### Playground equipment preferences

Respondents ranked individual features:

- Most favored: Log Scramble, Climber Play Structure with Slides, Climbing Tree, Double Belt Swings
- Least favored: Play Stack, Spinners (KidMixer & WhirlAround)

#### **Playground concept preferences**

- Option 1 and Option 2 were nearly equally as popular
- Option 3 was least preferred (60% ranked it last)

#### **Community feedback themes**

- Strong support for climbing, swinging, and nature-inspired features
- Preference for equipment that accommodates a range of ages
- Interest in shaded seating and picnic areas for families
- Desire to preserve the park's natural setting




